i. 2017 Paving Plan (see attached Roadway Survey)

Discussion of a broken stormwater pipe yielded more information to assess the situation.

Discussion of leaf collection yielded a desire to adjust the schedule to allow for pick-up later into the season.

iv. Library Sidewalk – widening

There was Committee discussion of DPW effort necessary to widen the sidewalk from the pavilion to the Andrew Bayne Library after the winter season.

v. Pool Employees Certification

Councilperson Menosky discussed the need for more employees to be Certified for the swimming pool operation. DAS Borczyk informed him that the budgeted new-hire would be required to be certified and he would like to find a way to get a third employee certified.

Councilperson Lenard asked DAS Borczyk if he could have DPW stabilize the Road Closed Signs on Sumner Avenue to keep them from being moved from private residences. He suggested that they be chained to cinder blocks.
