DPW Committee Meeting Minutes
February 7, 2017

I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough DPW Committee was called to order at 5:45 P.M. by Councilperson Lenard.

In attendance were Councilpersons Lenard, Menosky, DAS Borczyk and HRG Representative Gilberti. Councilperson Saylor and DPW Director Olczak were absent.

IV. Old Business:

i. Update – 2017 Paving Plan

General discussion and review of Councilperson Hrynda's suggestions yielded a list of streets to be submitted to Engineer Gilberti for estimate calculation and further discussion by Council. DAS Borczyk was asked to submit an email to Engineer Gilberti with the listed streets.

ii. DPW Laborer Applicant Update

DAS Borczyk informed the Committee that over 500 applicants had been received for the DPW position, with the deadline being February 10, 2017.

V. New Business

i. Sanitary Sewer Project Bid Review

HRG Engineer representative Gilberti recommended that the Sanitary Sewer bid be awarded to the low bidder, Jet Jack, Inc. at a bid of \$ 148,318. DAS Borczyk

informed the Committee that Jet Jack had done Consent Decree work for the Borough in the past. Councilperson Menosky made a Motion to include the awarding of the bid on the agenda of the February 14, 2017 Pre-Council Meeting.

ii. ALCOSAN Grow Grant

DAS Borczyk briefed the Committee on the receipt of the \$ 189,600.00 Grant under Cycle I of the program. The contract was under review.

Councilperson Menosky made a Motion to discuss the West Riverview Wall bid preparation by HRG Engineering at the February 14, 2017 Pre-Council Meeting. Councilperson Lenard seconded the Motion.

Tom Kelly, DPW employee, discussed the need to hire a new DPW Supervisor. Mr. Kelly also suggested that the DPW opening be filled by someone that does not reside within the Borough of Bellevue.
