I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough DPW Committee was called to order at 5:45 P.M. by Councilperson Lenard.

In attendance were Councilpersons Lenard, Saylor, DAS Borczyk, HRG Representative Gilberti. Councilperson Menosky 5:55 P.M. arrival.

IV. Old Business:

i. 2017 Paving Plan – Finalize

Engineer Gilberti reviewed the cost estimates for proposed streets for the 2017 Paving Plan. Several options were discussed to keep the efforts within budget. Councilperson Saylor made a Motion to Finalize the 2017 Paving Plan as specified and include it on the Agenda of the March 14, 2017 Pre-Council Meeting for action. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Menosky.

ii. DPW Laborer Interview

DAS Borczyk updated the Committee on the large number of applicants for the position and the process, moving forward, for interviews and presentation of several candidates for Committee review.

iii. West Riverview Wall Bid

HRG Engineer Gilberti gave a short update.

Councilperson Lenard discussed the moving of street barriers from the damaged area of Straw Avenue. DAS Borczyk was to place an order for water-filled barriers to discourage their movement.

V. New Business:

i. Emsworth Bridge Project – Bellevue Street Use

DAS Borczyk briefed the Committee on the request of Mosities Construction to use a short portion of Lincoln Avenue for materials transportation for a bridge project in Emsworth. It was noted that several daily trips of large vehicles would be occurring. That section of street is ranked poorly on the streets assessment. It was noted to delay paving plans until the end of that project (1 year).

VI. Public Comment

Tom Kelly, DPW Employee, informed the Committee that Emsworth was eliminating some of their brick streets and asked if we could approach them about taking the bricks, as, out inventory of spares for Bellevue brick street work is very low.
