I. Roll Call

A meeting the Bellevue Borough Department of Public Works Committee was called to order at 5:45 P.M. by Councilperson Lenard.

In attendance were Councilpersons Lenard, Menosky, Saylor, DAS Borczyk and HRG Representative Gilberti.
