**I. Roll Call**

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Parks and Recreation Committee was called to order at 5:00 P.M. by Councilperson Heffley.

In attendance were Councilpersons Heffley, Lenard, Hrynda, DAS Borczyk, Library Director Goodman, HRG Engineer Gilberti and Maureen Grant, Pool Manager.

**II. Public Contribution (5 minutes per person)**

Brian Baird and Shawn Ridge informed the Committee of a skate competition in which they would like to include Bellevue on May 20-22, 2017. DAS Borczyk was to receive insurance and waiver information and pass the waiver on to Solicitor Racunas.

Ellen Goodman, Library Director, reviewed the report with the Committee.

The Committee discussed the condition of the bleachers at Memorial Park. Action needed included having them sanded down and painted and renting to own new units.

Councilperson Coder informed the Committee that the weeds at Bayne Park were not well maintained and stumps from cut trees were exposed.

Councilperson Coder identified Sota Construction as a possible contractor for the West Riverview Wall.

The Committee discussed the bad condition of the bleachers at the Memorial Park Ballfield and asked that it be placed on the May 9, 2017 Pre-Council Agenda for discussion.
