I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Parks and Recreation Committee was called to order at 5:00 P.M. by Councilperson Heffley.

III. Reports

i. Bayne Library Report

Ellen Goodman, Library Director, reviewed the report with the Committee. Included was the start of the Farmer's Market on June 28, 2017.
