Public Safety Committee Minutes

I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Safety Committee was called to order at 6:35 P.M. by Councilperson Coder.

In attendance were Councilpersons Coder, Saylor, Mayor Cusick, DAS Borczyk, Code Enforcement Officer Delcroix, Police Chief Sentner, Fire Marshall Wissner, Police Officers Dunker and Lucas. Fire Chief Prichard was absent.

IV. Old Business:

- i. Police Department restructure plan – Update.

Chief Sentner informed the Committee that he would check with the Civil Service Committee as to the progress of the creation of a list of candidates for hiring. He also noted that he was forwarding a cost spreadsheet of expenses involved in the hiring of a part-time police officer.

- ii. Traffic Monitor System for North Avenue – Update.

DAS Borczyk informed the Committee of a meeting of the Fire Chiefs concerning the Act 172 Volunteer Firefighter/EMT tax credit. The meeting will be held on July 10, 2017 at Emsworth Borough.

Councilperson Coder asked as to the status of the Sign Ordinance. DAS Borczyk informed the Committee that the last action was to submit to the Tri-Boroughs Planning Commission for its input.

Fire Marshall Wissner discussed a specific resident issue as it pertains to the Open Burning Ordinance and the possible misuse of emergency services.

Mayor Cusick informed the Committee that there would be a Town Center Associates presentation on August 8, 2017 at 6 P.M., prior to the Pre-Council Meeting.
