I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Safety Committee was called to order at 6:30 P.M. by Councilperson Saylor.

In attendance were Councilperson Saylor, Mayor Cusick, DAS Borczyk, Code Enforcement Officer Delcroix, Police Chief Sentner, Fire Marshall Wissner, Fire Chief Pritchard Sr., Fire Captain Pritchard Jr., Keith Jankowski Northwest EMS and Councilperson Mike Kendall. DAS Borczyk was informed by Councilperson Saylor that Councilperson Kendall had been appointed to the Public Safety Committee by Council President Heffley.

III. Reports - None.

IV. Old Business:

i. EIT Credit for Volunteer Fire Fighters

Fire Chief Pritchard Sr. reviewed the discussions from the Fire Chief's Meeting as coordinated by the Quaker Valley COG.

ii. Ordinance Adjustment for West Avenue

DAS Borczyk asked for assistance in documentation of the adjustment to Ordinance 10-10 for public parking adjacent to the former ER at Suburban Hospital. Councilperson Saylor made a Motion to include this subject on the agenda of the Pre-Council Meeting on August 8, 2017. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Kendall

V. New Business:

i. Add on module for police RMS for vehicle maintenance and record keeping. Cost to be shared among Ross, Shaler and Bellevue.

Chief Sentner informed the Committee that the cost to Bellevue was \$ 2,237.00. Councilperson Saylor made a Motion to include this subject on

the Agenda of the Pre-Council Meeting of August 8, 2017. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Kendall.

- ii. Replacement of speed bumps at Bellevue Memorial Park stop signs.

Councilperson Kendall made a Motion to include this issue on the agenda of the August 8, 2017 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Saylor.

- iii. Addition of 10 new permit parking spaces in Lot 2.

Councilperson Saylor made a Motion to include this item on the agenda of the August 8, 2017 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Kendall.

- iv. Parking meter replacement/removal – Discussion.

Mayor Cusick discussed the alternatives for parking collection systems. Chief Sentner will provide the Committee with cost to re-program the existing meters.

- v. Surveillance camera systems for 2018 – Discussion.

Chief Sentner informed the Committee that an integrated system would be a Capital Improvement item for the 2018 Budget.

- vi. Request from Bellevue's Emergency Management team to purchase a siren controller from Sentry Siren for \$2,515.74. (From budget line item 01.415).

Fire Marshall Wissner discussed the need for the siren to inform residents of specific emergency situations. Councilperson Saylor made a Motion to include this item on the agenda of the August 8, 2017 Pre-Council Meeting.

Fire Marshall Wissner informed the Committee that all fire employees would be attending a CPR Instructor Class at CCAC at a cost of \$ 200 per person. This item was included in the 2017 Budget.

Mayor Cusick asked DAS Borczyk that an envelope addressed to him by the US Census Bureau be forwarded to our Census Enumerator, Terri Godkin.

The Committee asked that the Fire Safety Committee resume meeting on August 21, 2017 at 6 P.M. Any agenda items should be forwarded to Ann Moss.
