



**Borough of Bellevue**  
**DPW Committee Meeting Minutes**

I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough DPW Committee was called to order at 5:55 P.M. by Councilperson Lenard.

In attendance were Councilperson Lenard, Menosky, Saylor, DAS Borczyk and HRG Representatives Gilberti/Grail.

II. Public Contribution (5 Minutes per person) - None.

IV. Old Business:

i. DPW Candidates

Councilperson Lenard reviewed with Council the interview packets that were distributed.

ii. DPW Supervisor Search

Councilperson Lenard reviewed with Council the interview packets that were distributed. DAS Borczyk submitted copies of twelve (12) candidates for review by the Committee. Councilperson Lenard asked that Committee members narrow down to three or four candidates by the Pre-Council Meeting of May 9, 2017.

iii. Sewer Lining Project.

Engineer Gilberti informed the Committee that the Sewer Lining Project was in progress and the contractor would be working in the Borough for the next 2-3 weeks.

iv. Sumner Avenue

DAS Borczyk informed the Committee that DCED informed him that the Sumner Avenue Project was eligible for an AIM Loan. Councilperson Menosky made a Motion to include this item on the Agenda of the May 9, 2017 Pre-Council meeting. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Saylor.

V. New Business:

i. Glaser Avenue Street needs: Mr. Hain

DAS Borczyk submitted the timeline for the events as Mr. Hain reviewed the events of the project from ten (10) years ago. The Committee suggested that the Glaser Avenue project be forwarded to the Intergovernmental Committee so that we can assure that the Borough and School District are working together towards a solution.

ii. 2017 Paving Plan-Bids.

Engineer Gilberti informed the Committee that the initial review of the submitted bids showed Folino Construction as the low bidder at \$ 189,182. Councilperson Menosky made a Motion to include this item on the Agenda of the May 9, 2017 Pre-Council meeting. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Saylor.

iii. OVR Free Temporary employment

DAS Borczyk explained this program to the Committee and the eligibility of Bellevue to secure a seasonal employee as a result. Councilperson Menosky made a Motion to include this item on the Agenda of the May 9, 2017 Pre-Council meeting. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Saylor.

iv. Intergovernmental Committee Role

Councilperson Lenard made a Motion to include this item on the Agenda of the May 9, 2017 Pre-Council meeting.

VI. Public Contributions

Councilperson Coder discussed some issues with maintenance at Bayne Park. Councilperson Menosky made a Motion to include the “adopt a bumpout” program as suggested to be performed by Councilperson Coder on the agenda of the May 9, 2017 Pre-Council Meeting. Councilperson Saylor seconded the Motion.

Tom Kelly, DPW employee, asked about the DPW Supervisor and the road project in Emsworth that may yield bricks for the Borough of Bellevue. DAS Borczyk informed

the Committee that the Emsworth Borough Secretary informed him that the project was scheduled for 2018.
