



**Borough of Bellevue
Public Safety Committee Minutes

I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Safety Committee was called to order at 6:30 P.M. by Councilperson Coder (Chair).

In attendance were Councilpersons, Coder, Kendall, and Saylor. Mayor Cusick, DAS Borczyk, Code Enforcement Officer Delcroix, Fire Marshall Wissner, Fire Chief Pritchard and NorthWest EMS representative Jankowski. Police Chief Sentner was Absent.

II. Public Contribution (5 minutes per person):

- i. Presentation by Sabreena Woods of PCRG to present Conservatory Program. Councilperson Kendall made a Motion to include this item on the Agenda of the October 10, 2017 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Saylor.
