I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Safety Committee was called to order at 7:03 P.M. by DAS Borczyk.

In attendance were Councilpersons Pennington, Pikul. Mayor Marburger, DAS Borczyk, Police Chief Sentner, Code Enforcement Supervisor Delcroix, Fire Marshal Wissner and Fire Chief Pritchard. Councilperson Saylor (Chair) was absent.

II. Public Contributions (5 minutes per person) - None.

III. Reports - None.

IV. Old Business:

- i. Police hiring to include approved number of positions and current status of hiring process.

Chief Sentner reviewed progress on candidate list and hopes to have recommendations by the February 27, 2018 Council Meeting.

V. New Business:

- i. AIM Loan – Straw Avenue; Waterline Damage

DAS Borczyk reviewed history of decision to use AIM Funds for the project. Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to include AIM Loan – Straw Avenue; Waterline Damage on the Agenda of the February 13, 2018 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington.

- ii. Lincoln/N. Balph Left Turn Signal.

Council President Fodi discussed the issue with Chief Sentner. Chief Sentner is awaiting a cost estimate.

- iii. Dangerous Driving conditions – N. Balph/Teece/Orchard.

Councilperson Pikul informed Chief Sentner of a resident's concern about the number of accidents and near misses at this intersection.

- iv. Curfew –Borough Building. Extend from 10:00 p.m. until midnight on weekends.

There was general discussion of the Committee for the reasons for the request. It was suggested that a future Executive Session of the Committee be held to discuss the subject.

Chief Sentner discussed the potential of a Parking Permit area.

- vi. Request for No Parking sign to be removed at 624 West Avenue.

Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to include this issue on the agenda of the February 13, 2018 Pre-Council Meeting for discussion. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington.

- vii. MOTION: Councilperson Pennington made a Motion to include the purchase two replacement portable police radios per budget. (Budget Account No. 01.410.217.) on the Agenda of February 13, 2018 Pre-Council Meeting. (For action on February 27, 2018). The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul.

Upon the request of Chief Sentner, Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to include the purchase of a system add-on to the Shared Information System in an amount not to exceed \$ 3,460.00. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington.

Councilperson Pritchard asked why the paid firefighters were not in compliance with their contract requirement to respond to First Responder and Vehicle Rescue details.

Fire Marshal Wissner informed the Committee that the he is attending a Fire Training Class and that the Siren Controller has been installed.
