I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough DPW Committee was called to order at 6:30 P.M. by Councilperson Woshner (Chair).


There was Committee discussion about video recording the storm sewer line at Union & Glaser Avenues in response to a request of a resident. The situation is quite complex and on private property.
