



Council Minutes
April 24, 2018

I. Call to Order

At 7:00 P.M. Councilperson Fodi (President) called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a Moment of Silence.

II. Roll Call

Councilpersons Fodi (President), DiTullio, Hause, Pennington, Pikul, Pritchard and Woshner. Mayor Marburger, Treasurer Scioscia, Solicitor Racunas and DAS Borczyk were present. Councilpersons Hrynda and Saylor were absent.

III. Public Contribution (5 minutes per person).

Sean Ridge asked permission for Skateburgh Event to take place on June 24, 2018, similar to that of 2017.

John Basile, 31 Union Ave, discussed landslide concerns and the Maintenance of Apple Way.

IV. Approval of Meeting Minutes:

Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to Approve the following Meeting Minutes:

The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Woshner and carried via voice vote.

V. Committee Chair Reports:

a. Finance:

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to appoint Paul Cusick to the position of elected Auditor for the Borough of Bellevue. Councilperson Woshner discussed aspects of the position. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington and carried via six (6) to one (1) roll call vote. (Woshner-Nay).

b. DPW:

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to lease a 2018 Ford F 350, 4x5 Cab Plow & Salter at an amount not to exceed \$42,436.00 over four (4) years. (Budget No. 01.430.740.) DAS Borczyk discussed the terms of the lease. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via unanimous roll call vote.
- ii. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to purchase Fuel Tank for DPW facility at an amount not to exceed \$5665.00. DAS Borczyk discussed financing options and need as identified during MS4 Audit. (Budget Account No. 01.430.740.) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson DiTullio and carried via unanimous roll call vote.
- iii. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to accept A. Folino Construction Inc., the winning bidder, for the 2018 Paving Plan at an amount of \$ 479,029.52. (Budget Account No. 01.438.100.) Councilperson Fodi commented on the issues with the same vendor during the 2017 Paving Plan. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via six (6) to one (1) roll call vote. (Fodi-Nay).
- iv. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to approve 2018 OVR My Work Initiative Summer Program for Bellevue Borough (no cast to Borough). The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington and carried via voice vote.

c. Public Safety:

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to appoint David Casale to serve on the Joint Planning Commission. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pritchard and carried via five (5) aye to two (2) nay roll call vote. (DiTullio, Woshner-Nay).
- ii. MOTION: Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to approve lease of police vehicle at an amount not to exceed \$44,430.00 over three (3) years. (Budget Account No. 01.410.700.) Councilperson Pritchard commented that he preferred the car to be "marked". The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Hause and carried via six (6) aye to one (1) nay roll call vote. (Pritchard-Nay).
- iii. Police Dept.: National Prescription Drug Take Back Day: April 28, 2018 from 10 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- iv. Councilperson Pikul reminded Council of the Active Shooter Program on April 28, 2018 from 7-9 P.M.

Councilperson Fodi commented that there was a need to improve the relationship of first responders between Bellevue and Avalon.

d. Parks & Rec:

- i. MOTION: After discussion, Councilperson Pennington made a Motion to approve Skateburgh USA Event to be held in Bayne Park on June 24, 2018 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via voice vote.

VI. Resolutions:

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to approve Resolution No. 04-18, hiring of seasonal DPW employees. (Budget Account No. 01.430.140.) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via unanimous roll call vote.
- ii. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to approve Resolution No. 5-18 authorizing the donation of abandoned or unclaimed bicycles to Communicycle. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

iii. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to approve Resolution No. 06-18 authorizing the hiring of seasonal pool employees for the 2018 summer season. (Budget Account No. 01.452.130 and No. 01 452.131.) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Ditullio and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

VII. Ordinance:

i. MOTION: Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to introduce and advertise Ordinance No. 18-02 Adjustment of Non-Uniform Employee Pension in an amount not to exceed \$100.00. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington and carried via six (6) to one (1) roll call vote. (Woshner-Nay)

VIII. Old Business:

i. MOTION: Motion to accept the winning bidder for Streetscape Construction payable through the Quaker Valley COG. There was no motion made as there were issues with the pricing on the winning bid.

Councilperson Woshner asked that the streets to be paved for the 2018 plan be placed on the Borough Website.

Councilperson Pritchard asked that Lincoln Avenue be maintained.

IX. New Business: - None.

X. Approval of Bill List:

i. MOTION: Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to approve payment of the 04.24.18 Bill List. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington and carried via six (6) to one (1) roll call vote. (Woshner-Nay). Councilperson Hause requested more detail on the CEC invoice.
