I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Parks and Recreation Committee was called to order at 6:00 P.M. by Councilperson Hrynda (Chair).

In attendance were Councilpersons Hrynda (Chair), Pennington and Pritchard. DAS Borczyk, Library Director Goodman, Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo, HRG Representatives Gilberti and Krell and Pool Manager Grant. Mayor Marburger also attended the meeting.

III. Reports

- i. Library report – Library Director Goodman reviewed her report with the Committee.
- ii. Memorial Park Pool – Pool Manager Grant informed the Committee that there was record attendance at the Pool on Memorial Day.

- i. Councilperson Pritchard made a Motion to include the Photo Gallery at Bayne Park in partnership with Capture Pittsburgh on the Agenda of the June 12, 2018 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington.
- ii. DPW Supervisor Giammatteo informed the Committee that Playground excavation was underway in Bayne Park for the equipment installation for the CDBG Playground upgrade (Pirate Ship unit) and would be complete around June 15, 2018.

- ii. Discussion – Bellevue Dog Park.  
Members of the Bellevue Dogwoods Association proposed the 2018 Dog Swim on September 3 including an all-day doggie wellness event. Councilperson Pennington made a Motion to include the event on the Agenda of the June 12, 2018 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pritchard.
- iii. Councilperson Pennington made a Motion to approve the Free pizza slice offer from Pizza Bomonti during the Bayne Park Concert Series event on June 20, 2018. The motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pritchard.
- iv. Councilperson Pennington made a Motion to permit Avalon Residents to use the Bellevue Pool while the Avalon Pool is closed for repair, upon presentation of a valid pool pass. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pritchard.  
Councilperson Pritchard inquired about sidewalks on Bellevue Road. It is a Ross Township responsibility.
