I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Safety Committee Meeting was called to order at 7:06 P.M. by Councilperson Pikul.

DPW Supervisor Giammatteo was securing bids for new units.

- vi. Purchase of fire hose and appliances not to exceed \$6,000 as per budgeted line item 411.249.

This subject was to remain in Committee.


VI. Public Contributions – None.
