I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Safety Committee Meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Councilperson Saylor (Chair).

DAS Borczyk informed the Committee that an antiquated exit door to the Borough Building Fire Escape, from the Fire Department area, had been replaced.
