Parks Minutes

I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Parks and Recreation Committee was called to order at 6:00 P.M. by Councilperson Hrynda (Chair).

In attendance were Councilpersons Hrynda (Chair), Pennington and Pritchard, DAS Borczyk, Library Director Goodman, HRG Representatives Gilberti and Krell, Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo and Pool Manager Grant.

II. Public Contributions (5 minutes per person.)

Collin Kyle, Boy Scout Troop 226, explained his proposed Eagle Scout Project – Refurbishing Memorial Baseball Field – to the Committee. Councilperson Pennington made a Motion to Approve the project (at Committee level). The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pritchard and carried via voice Committee vote.

Paul Miller, 105 Grant Avenue, complemented band performing at Bayne Park on July 25, 2018 (Uptown Rhythm & Brass).

- ii. Pool Manager Maureen Grant reported to the Committee that attendance slowed in July. Pool would be open daily through August 19 and weekends through Labor Day. She also discussed her policy for closing due to weather conditions.

- ii. After discussion, Councilperson Pritchard made a Motion to Approve (at Committee Level) the Request for usage of Bellevue Memorial Park for CMU League as specified in Field Usage Priority System. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington and carried via Committee vote.
- iii. Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo informed the Committee that the Concrete Pads for Garbage Cans will be completed the week of August 13, 2018.
- iv. Davy Tree Proposal for lawn care – proposals to be sought by DPW Supervisor Giammatteo for 2019 work.
- v. Ban on dogs in Bayne Park – to be removed from Committee Agenda.

DPW Supervisor Giammatteo informed Council that he would check on wording changes on signs.

Councilperson Hrynda discussed sand blasting and epoxy coating on swimming pool.

Councilperson Pritchard inquired on sidewalks to Memorial Park.


VI. Public Contributions - None.
