I. Roll Call

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Safety Committee meeting was called to order at 7:01 P.M. by Councilperson Saylor.

In attendance were Councilpersons Saylor (Chair), Pennington and Pikul. Mayor Marburger, DAS Borczyk, Police Chief Sentner, Code Enforcement Supervisor Delcroix, Fire Chief Dailey. Councilperson Fodi and Ms. Zacchara of NW EMS as guests. Fire Marshal Wissner arrived late.

II. Public Contributions (5 minutes per person.) - None.

III. Reports - None.

IV. Old Business:

- i. After discussion, generally suggesting 24/7 enforcement and 2 hour time limit, Councilperson Pennington Made a Motion to include Permit Parking – N. Fremont on the Agenda of the May 8, 2018 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul.
- ii. Open Burning Permit is with the Solicitor for review.
- iii. After discussion and Committee recommendation, Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to include Loading Zone – Lincoln Avenue on the Agenda of the May 8, 2018 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington.
- iv. Councilperson Fodi discussed the Relaxation of Open Container Law – Bayne Park. Councilperson Pikul reviewed that the LCB has in Southside Pittsburgh. Councilperson Pennington discussed his opposition and the subject will remain in Committee.

V. New Business:

- i. Police Chief Sentner informed the Committee that PennDOT is responsible for the West Riverview Avenue in area of a citizen inquiry about a stop sign near the hospital.
- ii. After discussion, Councilperson Pennington made a Motion to include the Civil Service discussion & recommended for rule amendments, as per

Chief Sentner, on the Agenda of the May 8, 2018 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul.

- iii. After discussion, change in Police Vehicle allocation, marked versus unmarked as per inquiry of Councilperson Pritchard, will remain in Committee.
- iv. Chief Sentner discussed notification policy as it pertains to seized bicycles, as per inquiry of Councilperson Pikul.
- v. Chief Sentner reviewed Fee schedule Amendment as per suggested increase for street closings covering major projects. Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to include this item on the Agenda of the May 8, 2018 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was seconded by Councilperson Pennington.
- vi. Chief Sentner discussed an Ordinance to regulate times for the Delivery truck time regulation for the business district. This item will remain in Committee.

Other items discussed included;

- Mayor Marburger – re-establishment of Drug Task Force as organized by Mayor Cusick.
- Councilperson Pikul – Blight Committee working on criteria list for next meeting on May 14, 2018.
- Fire Marshall Wissner – The emergency siren controller is in place and testing will begin shortly.

John Manzella discussed parking violations on Orchard and North Jackson Avenues.


Doreen Chimner, 143 Meade Avenue, discussed the need for permit parking on Meade Avenue.
