ORDINANCE NO. 18 - 08

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BELLEVUE, A HOME RULE
MUNICIPALITY IN THE COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, IN THE COMMONWEALTH
OF PENNSYLVANIA; DESIGNATING A PORTION OF NORTH FREMONT AS A
RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING DISTRICT IN ACCORDANCE WITH
ORDINANCE NO. 93-7**

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bellevue, in the County of Allegheny and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: The following area shall be designated as a Residential Permit Parking District in accordance with Ordinance 93-7:

“NORTH FREMONT AVENUE - It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any vehicle to park such vehicle on the western most side of North Fremont Avenue between Lincoln Avenue and 200 linear feet north of Lincoln Avenue, up to and including in front of 27 North Fremont Avenue, at any time without acquiring a parking permit from the Borough and without payment of the permit charge of \$10.00.


SECTION 2: Any ordinance, or part thereof, conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the affects this ordinance.

ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bellevue in lawful session duly assembled this November 27, 2018.


