**I. Call to Order**

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Parks Committee was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Councilperson Pennington

**II. Roll Call**

In attendance were Councilpersons Pennington and Pritchard, Library Director Goodman, HRG Representatives Gilberti and Krell, Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo, and Admin Representative Moss. Councilperson Hrynda and DAS Borczyk were absent.

**III. Public Contributions (5 minutes per person.)**

A representative from the Bellevue Dog Woods gave an update on the organization and current dog events in the park. She also requested to renew the annual lease to use the park.

**IV. Reports**

Library Director Goodman submitted a written report and gave an update on the Fall Fest and events at the Library. Due to concern voiced at the Budget Meetings, Director Goodman compiled a written list of facilities issues that need to be addressed.

Engineer Gilberti gave the following updates:

- A. HRG will request an extension for the DCNR grant at Bayne Park due to weather. The Playworld equipment for Bayne Park has been delivered to the installer and is awaiting dry land before installation.
- B. We should be able to purchase two more school-age pieces for Bayne Park with the CDBG funds recently allotted to us by another community's inability to perform the required work from the project.
- D. Concrete is being poured for ADA accessibility at Bayne Park.
- E. We are still working on the CDBG Gillott Field grant.

**VI. New Business:**

- Councilperson Pritchard wanted to confirm that the new playground pieces would not interfere with the potential splash pad concept from the Master Park Plan.
- Library Director Goodman wanted to reaffirm the desire to maintain the Education Center concept from the Master Park Plan.
- Councilperson Pennington requested that we consider a walking trail around Gillott Field when we do renovations there.


VII. Public Contributions – None.
