Public Safety Minutes
November 7, 2018

I. Call to Order

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Safety Committee was called to order at 7 p.m. by Councilperson Saylor (Chair).

II. Roll Call

In attendance were Councilpersons Saylor and Pennington, Police Chief Sentner, Fire Marshal Wissner, Fire Chief Dailey, Code Enforcement Officer Delcroix, Admin Personnel Moss. Mayor Marburger, Councilperson Pikul and DAS Borczyk were absent.

III. Public Contributions – None.

IV. Reports – None.

V. Old Business:

- i. Safety issues at Bayne Park.
Chief Sentner reported that his department has addressed the youth issue at Bayne Park.
- ii. Update on security camera installations.
Chief Sentner requested that the RFP for borough-wide camera system services be submitted to Solicitor Racunas for review.
Councilperson Saylor made a motion to include this request on the November 13, 2018 Pre Council Agenda. Motion was seconded by Councilperson Pennington. Motion passed unanimously.
- iii. Fire Marshal Wissner reminded council of the need for the replacement of main doors in the fire garage.
- iv. Councilperson Pikul submitted written questions regarding code enforcement.
 - a. Code Enforcement Officer Delcroix update the Committee of the current three-year rental inspection cycle. He then recommended that it be updated to a five-year cycle.
 - b. Code Enforcement Office Delcroix notified the Committee that the appeal hearing granted the owners of a property on Roosevelt until December 18th to complete work on the property.

VI. New Business

- i. Chief Sentner informed the Committee that a police department office employee was attacked by a visitor to the department. As a result, a safety expert was brought in to evaluate the safety of the borough buildings and hold a self-defense class for the employees.

Chief Sentner recommended the installation of a secure reception window to be installed at the police station to avoid future incidents. The written quote from Ibis Tek was included. Councilperson Pennington motioned to recommend the Ibis Tek quote to Council for approval on the Agenda of the November 13, 2018 Pre-Council Meeting. The motion was seconded by Councilperson Saylor. Motion carried.

- ii. Fire Chief Dailey agreed to add Fire Lieutenants Hartman and Wissner to the Early Alert System.


VII. Public Contributions – None.
