I. Call to Order

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Works Committee was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by Councilperson Woshner (Chair).

II. Roll Call

In attendance were Councilperson Woshner (Chair), DiTullio, and Pritchard, HRG Representatives Gilberti and Krell, Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo, and Admin Representative Moss. DAS Borczyk was absent.

III. Public Contributions – None.

IV. Reports

HRG Engineering Representative Gilberti reported:

- i. The advertisement of the MS4 Pollutant Reduction Plan requirement to hold a public hearing on 11/13/18 at 7 p.m.
- ii. The emergency sewer work needed for Union Avenue must involve West View Water due to a 36" waterline above the sewer line. Mr. Gilberti estimates that the work will need to take place starting on a Friday and working 24 hours a day until Monday morning. If a new back up occurs before the work can be coordinated, we will need to pump out the area.
- iii. The sewer smoke test work continues on S Fremont Avenue.
- iv. Mr. Gilberti offered to take Council on a site visit to W Bellevue Station at their convenience. He also offered any other locations such as Straw, Union, Roseridge, and Jacks Run.

Supervisor Giammatteo reported:

- i. Crews continue to patch potholes.
- ii. The leaf loader has had several mechanical issues which are being addressed as quickly as possible.

- iii. The Columbia Gas Cross-Bore Project is ongoing. A complete list of streets was presented.

V. Old Business:

- i. The paving of S Euclid and S Bryant by Columbia Gas will be postponed until 2019 due to Columbia Gas crews helping with natural disaster emergencies out of town.
- ii. Councilperson Woshner offered to postpone the Blight Committee update to Council until the December Pre-Council meeting in order to move forward with the MS4 and iWorQ at November Pre-Council and Council meetings respectively.

VI. New Business:

- i. Request for approval of iWorQ Road Software demonstration to be presented before the November 27, 2018 Council meeting.
- ii. Laborer Position - DAS Borczyk and Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo have the list narrowed down to three candidates. Councilperson Woshner would like to see the applications of the three.

VIII. Adjournment

Councilperson Pritchard made a Motion to Adjourn the meeting at 7:06 p.m. The Motion was seconded by Councilperson DiTullio. The meeting was adjourned.
