I. Call to Order

At 7:00 p.m. President Hrynda called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

II. Roll Call

Present were Councilpersons Hrynda, DiTullio, Fodi, Hause, Pennington, Pikul, Pritchard Saylor, Woshner and Jr. Councilperson King. Mayor Marburger, DAS Borczyk, Solicitor Racunas, Treasurer Scioscia, Police Chief Sentner and Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo.

III. Public Contribution (5 minutes per person):

- i. Sean Ridge – Skateburgh – 2019 Event-After discussion, Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to approve the Skateboard Event to be held in Bayne Skateboard Park on May 19, 2019 from 10:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Fodi and carried via voice vote.

IV. Approval of Meeting Minutes:

After adjustments made by DAS Borczyk, Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to approve the following Meeting Minutes:

The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Hause and carried via voice vote.

V. Reports:

- i. Mayor's Report – February 2019 Police Report-Mayor Marburger discussed her report with Council.

VI. Committee Chair Reports:

- a. Finance – Nothing to report.
- b. Public Safety:
  - i. MOTION: Councilperson Saylor made a Motion to approve bid of SCSi for 2019 camera project at an amount not to exceed \$57,680.74. (Budget Account No. 30.410.000.) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via unanimous roll call vote.
  - ii. Councilperson Pikul updated Council on the Fire Service Committee which included discussion on Standards of Operation and Chain of Command.
- c. Public Works:
  - i. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to approve subscription renewal for All Data at a cost not to exceed \$1,500.00. (Budget Account No. 01.430.461.) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson DiTullio and carried via unanimous roll call vote.
  - ii. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to approve Payment No. 2 (Final) 2018 Sanitary Sewer Lining Project – Contract 18-02 to Jet Jack, Inc. in the amount of \$107,492.56. (Budget Account No. 08.429.721.) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson DiTullio and carried via unanimous roll call vote.
  - iii. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to advertise the 2019 Paving and 2019 Sewer Lining Contracts at an amount not to exceed \$ 400.00. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via unanimous roll call vote (Budget Account No. 01.406.341).
- d. Parks:

Councilperson Hrynda notified Council that new playground equipment has been installed at Bayne Park.

VII. Resolutions:

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to approve Resolution No. 03-19 recognizing Local Government Week, April 7<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup>, 2019. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Woshner and carried via unanimous voice vote.

VIII. Ordinances:

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Pikul made a Motion for final reading and adoption of Ordinance No. 19-01 regulating designated loading zone locations and times of use. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Hause and carried via seven (7) to two (2) roll call vote. (Pritchard, Woshner - Nay).
- ii. MOTION: Councilperson Pikul made a Motion for final reading and adoption of Ordinance No's 19-04; 19-05; and 19-06; Humane Action Pittsburgh (Ordinance 19-08 removed from Motion). The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Hause and carried via unanimous roll call vote.
- iii. MOTION: Councilperson Pikul made a Motion for final reading and adoption of Ordinance No. 19-09 Liquor License Transfers. General discussion concerning the 2/3 majority vote requirement ensued by various Council members. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Hause and carried via six (6) to three (3) roll call vote. (Fodi, Saylor, Pritchard - Nay).

IX. Old Business:

Councilperson Woshner informed Council about the Pop-up Glass Recycling events held by the SRC.

Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to Approve the CLA for 202Tacos. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Saylor and carried via six (6) to three (3) roll call vote (DiTullio, Hause, Pritchard – Nay).

Solicitor Racunas suggested and Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to Approve the Good Neighbor Agreement (Resolution 8-19). After discussion, the Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Saylor and carried via seven (7) to two (2) vote (DiTullio, Hause – Nay).

Councilperson Pikul discussed an upcoming Quaker Valley Council of Governments meeting about the Route 65 corridor, a pop-up glass recycling event, Emergency Management Coordinator meeting and implementation of a district-wide meeting for District I of the Allegheny County Boroughs Association.

X. New Business:

- i. SINC Funding Opportunity for Lincoln Ave. Traffic Signal Upgrade – Discussion. Councilperson Saylor made a Motion to send a letter of

commitment for the grant, to include handicapped crossing signals. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and approved via voice vote (noting – Nay by Councilperson DiTullio.)

- ii. Awarding of National Fitness Campaign Healthy City Grant to Bellevue. (\$30,000.). DAS Borczyk reviewed the program with Council, who gave an informal voice approval to move on pending the program documentation.

XII. Approval of Bill List:

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to approve payment of the March 26, 2019 Bill List except for payment to Builder's Hardware for repair of rescue bay door. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Woshner and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

XIII. Public Contribution (2 minutes per person)

Cathy Hepner, 44 Meade Avenue, asked questions about the new Good Neighbor Agreement.
