I. Call to Order

At 7:00 P.M. President Hrynda called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

II. Roll Call

Present were Councilpersons Hrynda, DiTullio, Fodi, Hause, Pennington, Pikul, Woshner and Jr. Councilperson King. Mayor Marburger, DAS Borczyk, Solicitor Racunas, Treasurer Scioscia and HRG Representative Gilberti. Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo, Police Chief Sentner, Councilpersons Saylor and Pritchard were absent.

III. Public Contribution (5 minutes per person)

Angelo Taranto, Allegheny County Clean Air Project discussed requests made of the owner of the property on which Shenango Steel operated.

IV. Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to Approve the following Minutes:

Councilperson Hause suggested that the February 26, 2019 meeting minutes be withheld until revisions were made. The Motion was revised to omit the meeting.

The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington and carried via voice vote except for approval of Council Minutes of February 26, 2019.

V. Reports:

Councilperson Woshner discussed the ALOM Conference, highlighting the sessions on Blight and Street Opening Ordinances.

HRG Engineer Gilberti briefed Council on the Union Avenue sanitary line break, Paving Plan and Sanitary Sewer Pipe Lining Project

VI. Committee Chair Reports:

a. Finance – No report.

b. Public Safety:

i. MOTION: Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to replace PD and Admin servers utilizing HP government leasing options for 48-month agreement and labor costs for hardware installation from Itame at an amount not to exceed \$3,800.00. (Budget Account No.01.410.252.) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

c. Public Works:

i. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to approve purchase of sign making equipment at an amount not to exceed \$12,900.00. (Budget Account No. 30.430.000.) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

ii. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to award the 2019 Paving Project to Shields Asphalt Paving, Inc. at a cost not to exceed \$275,000. (Budget Account No. 1.438.100.) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Fodi and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

iii. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to award the 2019 Sanitary Sewer Lining Project to Insight Pipe Contracting, LLC at a cost not to exceed \$267,157,00. (Budget Account No. 08.429.721.) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

d. Parks:

i. MOTION: Councilperson Pennington made a Motion to approve 2019 Farmer's Market for 2019 summer season from June 5 – October 26, 2019. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Fodi and carried via voice vote.

ii. MOTION: Councilperson Pennington made a Motion to approve purchase of swimming pool filters at a cost not to exceed \$4,135.00. (Budget Account No. 01.452.373.) The Motion is Seconded by Councilperson Woshner and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

iii. MOTION: Councilperson Pennington made a Motion to approve Resolution No. 10-19 the hiring of seasonal pool employees for the 2019 Summer season. (Budget Account

No. 01.452.130 and No. 01.452.131.) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

- iv. MOTION: Councilperson Pennington made a Motion to approve a donation of \$3,000.00 for the annual Joint Community Day and Fireworks event to be held on June 20, 2019. (Budget Account No. 01.451.268). The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Woshner and carried via five (5) to two (2) roll call vote. (Fodi and Pikul nay).

Councilperson Hrynda informed Council that Avalon & Bellevue will be holding the annual Dumpster Day event on April 27, 2019 from 8:00 to 12:00 P.M. in the parking lot across from the Avalon Volunteer Fire Department.

VII. Resolutions:

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to approve Resolution No. 09-19 Refund of Real Estate Taxes. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

VIII. Ordinances:

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to advertise Ordinance No. 19-08 regarding unlawful sale of commercially bred animals in commercial establishments of the Borough of Bellevue at an amount not to exceed \$250.00. (Budget Account No. 01.406.341.) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

IX. Old Business

Councilperson Woshner discussed Jordan Tax Services efforts on delinquent trash, requested a budget for the 2019 Wizardvue Event and the 2018 final event report.
