Council Minutes
September 24, 2019

I. Call to Order

At 7:00 p.m. President Hrynda called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of Silence.

II. Roll Call

Present were Councilpersons Hrynda, DiTullio, Edmondson, Hause, Pennington, Pikul, Pritchard, Saylor and Woshner. Mayor Marburger, DAS Borczyk, Treasurer Scioscia and Solicitor Racunas.

III. Public Contributions - (5 minutes per person.)

Dusty Kirk, Rachel O'Neil, did a presentation for Council on a 51 Lincoln Ave. Project. The item would be included on the agenda of the October 8, 2019 pre-Council Agenda.

Thomas Fowler, 187 Dakota Avenue, Discussed 191, 193, 195 Dakota Avenue and emails from Code Enforcement Officer Delcroix. Solicitor Racunas reviewed the process necessary to move forward.

Cindy Vozza, 197 Dakota Avenue, requested that Council not pursue water remediation on the property.

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to approve Cameras for Memorial Park Hockey Rink – Security Consulting Solutions, Inc. in the amount of \$2660.02. (Budget Account No. 30.410.000) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

Councilperson Pikul informed Council that October 2, 2019 would be Walk to School Day, initiating from the Bellevue YMCA.

Councilperson Pikul also discussed the timing of the SINC Grant – Spring 2020.

c. Public Works:

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to ratify additional charges for repair of lateral line at 73 South Harrison Avenue at an amount not to exceed \$3,000. (Budget Account No. 08.429.720.) The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

d. Parks:

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to approve Penguins Foundation/Dek Hockey rink contingent upon Solicitor Racunas approval at a site preparation cost not to exceed \$ 66,149.00. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson DiTullio and carried via eight (8) to one (1) roll call vote. (Pikul-Nay).

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to approve Resolution 23-19 refund of Real Estate taxes due as a result of changes in assessed values and/or payments. Additional refunds supplied by Joe Nolan on September 18, 2019. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pikul and carried via unanimous roll call vote.

- v. Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to intervene in the Liquor Control Board Transfer of Liquor License – Maxwell’s Pizzeria. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Hause and carried eight (8) to (1) voice vote. (Saylor-Nay).

Councilperson Pikul informed Council of the Halloween Parade and Fall Festival on October 26, 2019, the Bike Run for Volunteer Fire Departments and the Fall Craft and Vendor Show at the Knights of Columbus on October 20, 2019.

- i. MOTION: Councilperson Woshner made a Motion to approve payment of the September 24, 2019 Bill List. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Hause and carried via eight (8) to one (1) roll call vote. (Woshner-abstained).


XII. Executive Session – None.
