



**Borough of Bellevue
Parks Minutes
February 4, 2020

I. Call to Order

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Parks and Recreation committee was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Councilperson Pennington (Chair).

II. Roll Call

In attendance were Councilpersons Pennington (Chair), Pritchard and Stuncard. DAS Cusick, Mayor Marburger, Library Director Goodman, Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo, HRG Representatives Gilberti, McGuire and Breslin.

III. Public Contributions (5 mins per person.)

Robert Loch from BAGAA explained the problems with a retaining wall that is close to collapsing. Also wanted Sandy loam for the filed.

Wendy Blazier from Dog Woods discussed the problems with the parking lot. She also asked for a letter in support of the Dog Woods for the application for a grant.

Don Gregory from Team Pittsburgh discussed their use of Dek Hockey and how they would use the one in Memorial Park. He said that they have 35 Bellevue kids at their facility. He discussed maintenance and usage.

IV. Reports:

- i. Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo informed the Committee that he is waiting for the steel and electric to place the scoreboard at the Dek Hockey Rink.
- ii. Gillott Field Playground Project – HRG Representative Breslin informed the Committee that the only bid for the project was in the amount of \$40,385.00 The budget is for \$25,000.00. HRG Representative Gilberti will certify with the QVCOG. The Borough is to pay \$5,000.00 plus the QVCOG costs. HRG Representative Breslin also discussed the possible DCNR grants available and placing a restroom facility at the Dek Hockey site. It would be a 50/50 grant for 2021.
- iii. Library Director Goodman informed the Committee that Bayne Library has been fine free for the first month. She is doing Summer planning for the Library.

V. Old Business:

- i. 2020 Summer Concert Series: Motion to be included on the February 11, 2020 Pre-Council Agenda for approval. Library Director Goodman informed the Committee that there is money for 4 or 5 concerts, and is trying to get support from Comcast, HRG and the Solicitor. She will contact Fred's Signs in Avalon to purchase a new street sign. Motion to approve the street sign will be included on the Pre-Council Agenda of February 11, 2020.
- ii. Gillott Field CDBG Playground Grant – Discussion – (Approved during the January 28, 2010 Council Meeting).

VI. New Business:

- i. Tennis Court fence repair – Penn Fencing submitted a low bid in the amount of \$1,559.00. Allegheny Fence – did not submit a bid.
- ii. Request from New Renaissance Theatre Company to host a summer event in Bayne Park – (This item will be included on the Pre-Council Agenda of February 11, 2020).
