I. Call to Order

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Safety Committee was called to order at 7:10 P.M. by Councilperson Pikul.

II. Roll Call

In attendance were Councilpersons Pikul (Chaired) and Pennington. DAS Borczyk, Mayor Marburger, Fire Chief Daily, Fire Marshall Wissner, Firefighter Hartman, Police Chief Sentner and Code Enforcement Officer Delcroix. Councilperson Saylor (Chair) was absent.

III. Public Contributions (5 minutes per person.)

Zack Frazier, 691 North Ave., discussed the enforcement of a Child Custody Order. Chief Sentner informed him that it is a Civil Matter and any action must be taken by the courts.

Jennifer Slavicek, 67 S. Bryant, discussed misinformation about discussions by Council concerning the Volunteer Fire Department and informed that they fundraise tirelessly.

V. Old Business:

- i. Humane Action Pittsburgh Items – Update.
Solicitor Racunas is reviewing. Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to have this item remain in Committee.
- ii. Liquor License Application for 202 Hometown Taco's – Update.
Councilperson Pikul informed the Committee that a Public Hearing is scheduled February 12, 2019 at 6:00 P.M.
- iii. Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to include the Parking Ordinance revision establishing loading zone on Hawley Ave. on the Agenda of the February 12, 2019 Pre-Council Meeting. Chief Sentner noted that this was an amendment to Ordinance 10-10 with hours of 6 AM to 6 PM. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington.
- iv. Councilperson Pikul requested Street issues – Hallett Ave. Permit Parking, Forest Avenue Signage, remain in Committee.

- v. Fire Station Curfew – Firefighter’s Meeting - Fire Safety Committee.
- vi. Councilperson Pikul made a Motion to include the Civil Service Update on the Agenda of the February 12, 2019 Pre-Council Meeting. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson Pennington.

Chief Sentner informed the Committee that a Consultant had done a security assessment.

Councilperson Pritchard discussed his attendance at a meeting discussing regionalization of the Emergency Management System.

Councilperson House was confused as to why the Liquor License Policy was part of the Public Safety Agenda, noting that standards need to be set.
