I. Call to Order

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Department of Public Works Committee was called to order at 6:40 P.M. by Councilperson Woshner (Chair).

i. Update – 2019 Paving Plan.

HRG Rep. Krell provided the Committee with estimates for suggested streets on the plan. Councilperson Pritchard made a Motion to include the preparation of Engineering estimates on the agenda of the February 12, 2019 Pre-Council Meeting for action on that date. Councilperson DiTullio Seconded the Motion.

ii. Discussion – Proposed revision of Parking Ordinance establishing a loading zone on Hawley Avenue.

This item was to be removed from potential business for the Committee.

iii. Update – New hire for DPW –

Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo recommended the hiring of Austin Lockhart for the Laborer position in his Department. Councilperson Pritchard made a Motion to include this item for approval on the February 12, 2019 Pre-Council Agenda. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson DiTullio.

- i. Sewer Lining Project – discussed by HRG Rep. Gilberti.

Councilperson Woshner discussed regionalization and asked that the condition of the alley near North Sprague Avenue be checked. Councilperson Woshner also suggested the use of a Geo-Technical Engineer to address the issue of underground springs in the community.

Councilperson Pritchard made a Motion to include the advertisement of Seasonal Employees on the Agenda of the February 12, 2019 Pre-Council Meeting for action on that date. The Motion was Seconded by Councilperson DiTullio.

VII. Public Contributions


There was general discussion about removing the brick surface on Kendall Avenue.
