I. Call to Order

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough DPW Committee was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Councilperson DiTullio, Chair.

II. Roll Call

In attendance were Councilpersons DiTullio, Edmondson, and Cerminara. Other attendees included DAS Cusick, Engineer Hazelwood, Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo, HRG Representatives Gilberti and Krell.

III. Public Contributions:

- i. Mr. Vozza requested update on Dakota Ave. bricks being replaced since mid-September. DPW Supervisor Giammatteo has on schedule to work on in better weather.

IV. Reports – None.

V. Old Business:

- i. Discussion of Paving Project – Columbia Gas is replacing a gas line on Kendall Avenue in 2021 with paving scheduled in 2022.
- ii. Discussion – West View Water Authority will be replacing a water line on Teece Avenue from N. Fremont to Watkins Avenue's.
- iii. Discussion – HRG stated their concerns about the condition of Lincoln Avenue from the Avalon line to Balph Avenue. It was noted that Columbia Gas will be replacing a line in about 5 years, but due to the condition of the street HRG noted that the work needs to be completed earlier than that.
- iv. Update – A manhole is needed on Keswick Avenue in order to televise the sewer line on Straw Avenue.
- v. Streetscape Update – Brad Hazelwood discussed phases 7 (from Mead to Balph Ave.) and Phase 8 (from Balph to Sheridan) of this project. He also reported that he is working with the county to merge the phases to get a better price. Additionally, he reported that the electrical needs of these phases require a new control box be installed due to the length of the circuits.
- vi. Military Banners: DAS Cusick proposed using the VFW Fund to help pay for hardware for military banners to be installed along Lincoln Avenue.

He noted that there are 34 poles which can accommodate 68 banners and a plan will be presented to Council in the near future.

- VI. New Business: None currently.
- VII. Public Contributions (5 minutes per person.) None at this time.
- VIII. Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 7:21 p.m.
