I. Call to Order

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Works Committee was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Councilperson DiTullio (Chair).

II. Roll Call

In attendance were Councilperson DiTullio, Edmondson, and Cerminara. Other attendees included DAS Cusick, Mayor Marburger, Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo, HRG Representatives Gilberti, McGuire and Krell.

III. Public Contributions (5 mins per person.) None.

IV. Reports

- i. Paving Project - HRG Representative Krell discussed the road paving projects, Lincoln (from Starr to Meade), Alley (Jefferson to Cauhey), Teece (Watkins to Fremont), N. Jackson, Beaver. Columbia Gas will be placing new pipe on Orchard from N. Sprague to Union – in sidewalk. Proposal will be submitted at the Pre-Council Meeting on February 11, 2020.
- ii. GIS Program – HRG Representative McGuire explained the proposed GIS program – data base, cloud storage, base maps, sewer and water topography. He explained the usage for infrastructure including specs, conditions, locations, Parks and maintenance, it can be accessed by phone or computer.

V. Old Business:

- i. Teece Avenue – HRG Representative Gilberti informed the Committee that the Borough will pave over the trench by West View Water when the weather breaks.

VI. New Business:

- i. Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo requested to add an easement behind 185 Kendall Ave. HRG Engineering will evaluate the slope and oversee the excavation. (This item will be added to the Pre-Council Agenda of February 11, 2020).

- ii. ALOM Conference – Councilpersons Pikul, Edmondson and Sloane will be the attending Spring ALOM conference at Seven Springs.
- iii. Bids for Dump Truck #2 – Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo discussed the bid for a dump truck in the amount of \$47,620 for cab and bed, \$31,840 for salt spreader and equipment.
- iv. Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo will be giving a tour of Streetscape to Council Members on Friday, February 7, 2020. He also informed the Committee that the Public Works crew is working on Dakota Avenue and the Brighton Road guardrail will be repaired.
- v. Banner Community – Mayor Marburger, Councilpersons Pennington, Hause and Pikul will be attending the Banner Community Recognition Event to be held on March 6, 2020 at PNC Park.
