I. Call to Order

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Parks and Recreation Committee was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Councilperson Pennington (Chair).

II. Roll Call

In Attendance were Councilpersons Pennington, Pritchard and Stuncard. DAS Cusick, Mayor Marburger, Library Director Goodman, Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo, HRG Representatives Gilberti, McGuire and Breslin.

Paul Miller, 105 Grant Ave., discussed relocating the new playground equipment to the old volleyball court.

- i. Library Report – Library Director Goodman discussed her report with the Committee and announced that there is a 48% increase in active users of the Library.
- ii. DPW Report – Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo reported that the steel is in for the Dek Hockey.

The Committee discussed Dek Hockey rules of use, third party use and street hockey. Mayor Marburger discussed obtaining background clearances.

VI. New Business:

- i. Library Copier Lease – The current lease runs out in May. Proposals were obtained from three vendors which were included in the packet. This item will be included on the Agenda of the March 10, 2020 Pre-Council Meeting.
- ii. Request for support of Labor Day Fireworks and Community Day Festivities. North Boroughs Fireworks Committee is requesting increasing support to \$3,200 from \$3,000. This item will be included on the Agenda of the March 10, 2020 Pre-Council Meeting.
- iii. The purchase of swimming pool paint in the amount of \$5,800.00 to Chem Masters (formerly Gateway Paints. Budget Account No. - 01.452.373.) Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo will provide price comparisons.
- iv. HRG Engineer Gilberti suggested putting in a DCNR Grant for the Restroom at the Dek Hockey. He also suggested a CDBG Grant for the wall at BAGA. Both are part of the Parks master plan.
