I. Call to Order

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Safety Committee was called to order at 7:09 p.m. by Councilperson Pikul (Chair).

- iv. Northwest EMS – Carl Tuscan, EMS Representative, provided reports for the Committee and will send them to the Police and Fire Departments. He also informed that Committee that Northwest EMS is under new management and that experienced personnel were hired.

VI. New Business:

- i. Allegheny County 2020 Hazards Mitigation Plan – M. Bookser, Emergency Management Coordinator, provided reports for Allegheny County Hazards Mitigation Plan which were included in the Council packet.
- ii. Creation of RFP for Third Party Inspection permits, Electrical permits, and Mechanical building permits – Discussion regarding our building inspection contractor and it was suggested by Code to put out RFP for this service.
- iii. No-Knock List – Existing Ordinance needs updated and is being sent to Solicitor Racunas for review.
- iv. Police Department and Fire Department remodeling – Police and Fire Departments will work together on a plan to remodel

their spaces in the building. USDA provides grants and loans for this purpose. Police and Fire offered tours for Council.

- v. Traffic safety update for Starr Avenue aka SR4012 and PennDOT evaluations – Crossing signals should be changed to have all traffic stop when people press the button. Chief Sentner has reported the situation to the State.
- vi. Creating a Civil Service hiring list for the Fire Department – Fire Department requested a Hiring list. DAS Cusick looking into costs.
- vii. Insurance for Volunteer Fire Company presented an invoice for insurance which the Borough agreed to pay for and will be included on the Bill List.
- viii. Traffic Signal at Route 65 and West Riverview Avenue – Public Works Supervisor will work on correct signage. Police chief Sentner will contact PennDot to recommend changes to signal. Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo will investigate contract with traffic signal vendors.


VII. Public Contributions (5 minutes per person.) None.
