I. Call to Order

A meeting of the Bellevue Borough Public Works Committee was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Councilperson DiTullio (Chair).

- i. DPW Report – None.
- ii. Engineering Report – HRG Engineer Gilberti informed the Committee that the sewer lining project was sent out for bids. Council was offered a site visit on March 13, 2020 of the GIS Systems.

- i. 185 Kendall Avenue – Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo and Engineer Gilberti informed the Committee that the hill seems too steep for a driveway and plan on meeting with the owners to discuss.
- ii. Traffic signal at Route 65 and West Riverview Avenue. – Public Works Supervisor Giammatteo will contact Bruce & Merrilees to discuss a service contract. The Public Works department will have the direction arrows painted when weather permits. Temporary signal box is being used due to accident. It needs replaced. May have to contact State to change lighting.

VI. New Business:

- i. The purchase of swimming pool paint in the amount of \$5,800.00 to Chem Masters (formerly Gateway Paints. Budget Account No. - 01.452.373.
- ii. Renewal of the ALLDATA software subscription in the amount of \$1,500.00. Budget Account No. 01.430.249 and normally split

with Police. ALLDATA is software used for automotive diagnostic and repair.

- i. HRG Representative Krell discussed placing 8-12 manholes per year to facilitate lining, removal of lampholes during paving projects. This will help the Borough obtain grants for relining sewers.
