<b>1</b>	<b>Andrew Bayne Memorial Library; Ellen Goodman, Director</b>	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Ms. Goodman reported that the library’s summer program is cancelled.</li> <li>▪ She asked for input on the Summer Concert series, noting that musicians have tentatively been lined up, but she is most concerned about the acts scheduled for June. Mayor Marburger suggested revisiting this in future meetings.</li> </ul>	
<b>2</b>	<b>Bellevue Parks; Ben Gilberti, HRG Engineers</b>	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Mr. Gilberti reported that he will be meeting with Ms. Bahn and Public Works staff at Memorial Park to discuss demolition of the existing fence and backstop as the contractor is prepared to start work beginning May 11.</li> <li>▪ As for Gillott Park, Mr. Gilberti related the history of the project, including the re-bid which resulted in one bid from Jeffrey Associates. He would like to have a discussion about the proposed location of the playground before accepting the bid. Children should be kept away from the parking lot; the current plan would put the playground next to it. Mr. Gilberti suggested that Public Works could handle clearing, grubbing and moving the flag pole. HrG will provide a schematic for Pre-Council so everyone understands the alternate proposal, which would relocate the playground to just past the batting cage.</li> </ul>

<b>1</b>	<b>Portajohn at Dog Park</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ It's believed that the portajohn installed at the park may have been for the convenience of the workers installing the Dek Hockey rink, and that it can be removed now..</li> </ul>
<b>2</b>	<b>Lawn Maintenance at Bayne Park</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The previous DPW Superintendent requested a quote for reseeding and fertilizing the grass at Bayne Park. With the park currently closed, and plans for the 2020 Farmers Market uncertain, this would be a good time to take care of the maintenance. The committee recommended having it done.</li> </ul>
<b>3</b>	<b>Farmers Market</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ In the absence of a pandemic, the Market would open June 3.</li> <li>▪ As a Plan B location, the Mayor suggested Teece Avenue.</li> </ul>
