| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Joe Scioscia, 256 Lincoln Avenue: Reported that a small tree across from 208 Brighton Road is leaning against a cable. Also stated that the guide rail on Brighton Road has not been addressed. | | |

| 1 | Engineer; Ben Gilberti, HRG Engineers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Mr. Gilberti reported that the paperwork to begin the 2020 Street Paving program is being reviewed, and a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled soon. ▪ Crews will be out soon to survey for the manhole work, and then the project will be put out to bid. ▪ Mr. Gilberti stated that Council will need to adopt resolutions in support of the grant applications for East and West Bellevue Stations. ▪ The Multimodal Transportation grant for funds to address the Riverview and Fremont signal is due at the end of September. ▪ The Alcosan GROW grant application for the fifth round is due at the end of July. ▪ In response to a question, Mr. Gilberti stated that he has talked with the DPW Superintendent about the “dip” on Orchard Avenue near North Balph Avenue. | |
| 2 | Public Works; Jim Kelly, Superintendent <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Mr. Kelly reported that Public Works have installed the scoreboard posts at the dek hockey rink. ▪ A Public Works crew was on Orchard Avenue, and the street should be more drivable by the end of the week. ▪ Mr. Kelly is sending laborers to work on Dakota Avenue as they are available. ▪ Bumpouts on Lincoln Avenue have been mulched. ▪ Public Works may need more bricks to replace those displaced by Columbia Gas; there is a suspicion that some may have been stolen. ▪ Mr. Kelly asked about plans for traffic signal maintenance and was told that the Police Chief would address in his report to the Public Safety Committee. | |
