

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON SPECIAL
ASSESSMENTS FOR ROADWAY and UTILITY RELATED
IMPROVEMENTS
IN THE VILLAGE OF EAST TROY**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, per Village ordinance, the need to levy special assessments upon properties for necessary repairs to Clayton and Bellview Avenues is required. The amount of the special assessments for sewer lateral lines, curbs/gutters, sidewalk approaches, sanitary sewer lateral improvements, and/or driveway approaches for these properties have been calculated.

Assessment District: The Assessment District includes all lands within the Village of East Troy which are described as follows: All properties abutting Clayton Avenue and Bellview Avenue between Chafin Avenue and Lenck Avenue.

If you would like to view the Special Assessment Report, a copy is available at the Village Hall during normal business hours. Alternatively, the report may be viewed on the Village's website at easttroywi.gov.

You are further notified that the Village Board shall hear all persons interested, or their agents or attorneys, concerning matters contained in the resolution authorizing such assessments and the above described report of the Village Engineer. The hearing shall be held on the 26th day of October, 2020 at 6:30 p.m., via Zoom Virtual Meeting (no in-person attendance).
