

ORDINANCE NO. 1008

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL BY MINORS AND PROHIBITING POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL BY ANY PERSON WITHIN PUBLIC PLACES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of El Paso, Woodford County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Chapter 110 of the city code of the City of El Paso is hereby amended by adding Article III Sections 110-18 through 110-20, which Article is set forth as follows:

**CHAPTER 110
ARTICLE III**

110-18 Possession and Consumption by Minors

It shall be unlawful for any person under twenty-one years of age to purchase, consume, or accept a gift of alcoholic liquor or to have liquor in his or her possession within the City of El Paso. For the purpose of this section, the presence in a vehicle other than a public omnibus of any alcoholic liquor shall be prima facie evidence that it is in the possession of and is being carried by, all persons occupying such vehicle at the time at which such alcoholic liquor is found, except where such vehicle contains at least one occupant over twenty-one years of age.

110-19 Possession in Public Places

It shall be unlawful for any person within the City of El Paso to possess or consume alcoholic liquor in any open public places including but not limited to streets, sidewalks, or other public gathering places.


110-20 Penalty

Any person violating any provision of this article shall be subject to a penalty of \$250.

SECTION TWO: That this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
