

ORDINANCE NO. 1021

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE EL PASO MUNICIPAL CODE BY LIMITING THE NUMBER OF LIQUOR LICENSES WITHIN THE CITY OF EL PASO

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso is charged with the responsibility of regulating and prohibiting certain acts, conduct, and offences for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare of its citizenry, and are authorized to pass ordinances not inconsistent with the criminal laws of this state; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the number of liquor licenses presently issued by the City and after considering the size and population of the City, have determined that the present number of licenses is adequate and the residence are adequately served by the business establishments which presently hold liquor licenses;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of El Paso, Woodford and McLean Counties, Illinois, by and through its statutory powers as follows:

SECTION ONE: The above recitals are incorporated herein and made a part hereof as if fully set forth in their entirety.

SECTION TWO: Chapter 110 §110-4 of the El Paso Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting the present §110-4 and inserting the following:

§110-4. Number of licenses.


There shall be issued in the City of El Paso no more than the following number of licenses to sell alcoholic liquor at retail:

<u>Class of License</u>	<u>Maximum Number of Licenses Issued</u>
Class A	1
Class B	2
Class C	7
Class D	0
Class E	2
Class F	7
Class G	2
Class H	3

SECTION THREE: That this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


