

ORDINANCE NO. 1027

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 110 OF THE EL PASO MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING LIQUOR LICENSES

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of El Paso, Woodford and McLean Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 110 §110-6(B) is hereby amended by adding an additional optional liquor license as §110-6(B)(3) to read as follows:


(3) The holder of a Class A license or a Class B license, or a Class C license may also acquire a Class I license in addition to the Class A, B, or C license. A Class I license shall authorize the holder of the Class A, B, or C license to own and operate one or more video gaming terminals within the licensed establishment provided the gaming terminals are operated within the conditions set forth in the Municipal Code. No video gaming terminals may be owned or operated within the City of El Paso unless located within a licensed establishment holding either a Class A license, Class B license, or Class C license, and addition thereto a Class I license.

SECTION TWO: The fee for a Class I license shall be \$750 per year and the license term and the method of payment of fees shall be the same as all other licenses permitted under Chapter 110 of the El Paso Municipal Code.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


