ALFRED R. RESTAINO, SR.

WHEREAS, Alfred R. Restaino, Sr., of Nutley New Jersey, is being remembered upon his passing from this life on Wednesday, December 30, 2015, at the age of 84; and

WHEREAS, Alfred R. Restaino, Sr., was born in Newark, New Jersey, and moved to Nutley, New Jersey, 54 years ago; and

WHEREAS, Alfred R. Restaino, Sr., graduated from Barringer High School and Carteret Preparatory School, where he lettered in football, baseball and basketball. He also was All-State third baseman at Carteret Preparatory School; and

WHEREAS, Alfred R. Restaino, Sr., graduated from Bloomfield College, where he lettered in baseball and basketball and earned a Master's Degree from Seton Hall University; and

WHEREAS, Alfred R. Restaino, Sr., began his teaching career at Lyndhurst (NJ) High School where he also served as an assistant football coach. He was an athletics administrator and coach for 34 years at Bloomfield College, serving as a baseball and basketball coach. As athletics director, he won multiple "Coach of the Year" honors and over 500 games combined. The Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference also presents an annual award in recognition of his service; and

WHEREAS, Alfred R. Restaino, Sr., was an Army Veteran of the Korean War, and owner/operator of Midtown Sporting Goods in Nutley, New Jersey. He was elected to the New Jersey State and Metro Newark ASA Software Hall of Fame and the Bloomfield College Hall of Fame; and

WHEREAS, Alfred R. Restaino, Sr., served as sergeant-at-arms for the New Jersey Senate, Senate Aide to Senator Carmen Orechio, Chief of Staff to State Senator Gary Furnari and State Assemblyman Ralph Caputo. He was also a member and chairman of the Nutley Planning Board and a commissioner and chairman of the North Jersey District Water Supply Commission; and

WHEREAS, Alfred R. Restaino, Sr., was preceded in death by four brothers, Ernie, Joe, Tony, and Pat. He leaves to cherish fond memories: his beloved wife, Patricia V. (Brough) Restaino; four children, Al, Jr., and his wife Denise, Carole Restaino, Rich and his wife Michele, David and his wife Leslie; eight grandchildren, Al, III, Danielle, Marissa, Bryan, Ben, Paige, Sophia and Olivia; and his brother, Jerry Restaino and his wife Francine; now, therefore, be it
