HONORING KYLE MOORE-BROWN  
HONOREE OF NEWARK FLIGHT FOOTBALL'S FREE YOUTH FOOTBALL CLINIC  
AUGUST 13, 2016

WHEREAS, Kyle Moore-Brown, AFL Hall-of-Famer and Newark Native will be honored as the special guest of Newark Flight Football during their Free Youth Football Clinic on Saturday, August 13, 2016, at Nat Turner Park in Newark, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Kyle Moore-Brown was born on February 26, 1971, in Newark, New Jersey. He attended the Newark Public School System and graduated from Central High School in 1989; and

WHEREAS, Kyle Moore-Brown attended the University of Kansas in Lawrence, Kansas, where he studied Early Childhood Development and played college football for the Jayhawks. During his college career, he was a 3-year starter at the University of Kansas, led the team in sacks his senior year with 15.5 sacks, led the team in defensive tackles, won the Aloha Bowl in 1992, and was featured in the NCAA College Football EA Sports Game in 1992; and

WHEREAS, during his professional career, Kyle Moore-Brown played for the Detroit Lions (1994) of the National Football League (NFL), the Albany/Indiana Firebirds (1995-2003) and the Colorado Crush (2004-2008) both of the Arena Football League (AFL). He played defensive lineman and center on the offensive side. Some of his career highlights and awards include the Foster Trophy, three-time All-Ironman Team (2002, 2005 & 2006), First Team All-Arena (2007), Second Team All-Arena (2008) and Arena Football Hall of Fame Inductee (2014). During his illustrious 13-year career, he played a league-record 236 consecutive games and retired in 2008 at the age of 37; and

WHEREAS, Kyle Moore-Brown has coached for Indoor Football League Teams since 2009 when he became the Assistant Head Coach of the La Crosse Spartans and then its Head Coach in 2010. Afterwards, he became the Head Coach of the Cedar Rapids Titans in 2011, the Defensive/Offensive Line Coach for the Iowa Barnstormers in 2012, the Assistant Head Coach/Offensive Line Coach for the Pittsburg Power in 2014, and currently he is the Associate Head Coach/Defensive Line Coach for the Nebraska Danger and has been since 2015; and

WHEREAS, Kyle Moore-Brown is a highly-motivated, skilled and professional football coach and is experienced in coaching players of all ages and levels. His diverse talent and experience includes team building strategies, player development, mentoring young men and coaching both offensive lineman and defensive linemen. He also spends time as a volunteer coach for Kaw Valley 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> grade football teams; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Essex County Board of Chosen Freeholders hereby commends and congratulates Kyle Moore-Brown as he is honored for his outstanding career in the Arena Football League during Newark Flight Football's Free Youth Football Clinic and proudly acknowledges him as a son of Essex County; and, be it further
