RE: Approval of Grant Award from the State of New Jersey, Division of Criminal Justice "Body Armor Replacement Fund" for the purchase of protective vests in the amount of \$10,784.17 and corresponding Budget Insertion.

INTRODUCTION:

The Division of Criminal Justice advised the Essex County Prosecutor's Office of a grant award in the amount of \$10,784.17 from the State of New Jersey's 2017 Body Armor Replacement Fund. The Prosecutor's Office intends to purchase body vests designed to protect the user against blunt force trauma associated with either the impact of a firearm projectile or from a knife or other pointed instrument. This grant will make possible the purchase of such vests for Prosecutor's Office Law Enforcement Officers, as to replace worn-out existing vests. No matching funds are required.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Essex County Board of Chosen Freeholders approve this grant award and insertion of funds into the County budget.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION:

Approval of this request will enable the Essex County Prosecutor's Office to purchase additional vests, thus reducing personnel exposure to injury or death in the course of carrying out their duties.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact on the Essex County Prosecutor's Operating Budget.

ALTERNATIVE:

There are no alternatives for the use of these funds.

The New Jersey Division of Criminal Justice is pleased to announce that your agency will receive \$10,784.17 under the State Fiscal Year 2017 State Body Armor Replacement Fund (BARF) Program. An electronic transfer of funds or an award check has been sent directly to your agency's Chief Financial Officer.

The State (BARF) Program assists all eligible law enforcement agencies to offset the costs of purchasing body vests for their officers. Although this is a five-year vest replacement program, program regulations encourage agencies to make every reasonable effort to expend their awards within one year of receipt.

In order to participate in the 2017 BARF Program, agencies are required to confirm that they have a written mandatory body armor wear policy for all uniformed officers engaged in patrol or field operations. Your agency is in compliance with having a policy and therefore is eligible to receive a 2017 BARF award.

All future State BARF program correspondence, such as application periods, award announcements, and award confirmations will be sent electronically, via e-mail. Failure to maintain updated contact information in the State BARF system may result in your agency not receiving important State BARF messages.
