SCOTT GEIGER

WHEREAS, Scott Geiger of Union, New Jersey, is being remembered upon his passing from this life on Monday, April 13, 2020, at the age of 47 of complications from COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Scott Geiger grew up in Nutley, New Jersey, where he lived until 2005, and resided in Union, New Jersey, for the last ten years. He graduated from Nutley High School in 1991 and attended Bergen Community College and Fairleigh Dickinson University; and

WHEREAS, Scott Geiger was a dedicated Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) for 30 years. He received his EMT Certification when he was only 17 years old and it has been his life's work ever since. As an EMT, he dedicated his life to helping others and he will be receiving a Line of Duty Death Honor Guard ceremony; and

WHEREAS, Scott Geiger worked for Atlantic Mobile Health for the past 17 years where he was one of their first and one of their longest standing team members. He worked in several Atlantic Mobile Health divisions including BLS Transport, Communications, Specialty Care Transport, and more recently 911 at EMS 8 in Mountainside and EMS 10 in Warren/Watchung. He served honorably in all of these areas, offering comfort and compassion to thousands of patients. He previously worked and volunteered at the Ironbound Ambulance Squad (Newark) and the Nutley Volunteer Ambulance Squad; and

WHEREAS, when not working as an EMT, Scott Geiger enjoyed playing billiards, spending time with his friends and goddaughter, visiting the Jersey Shore and rooting for the New York Jets; and

WHEREAS, Scott Geiger is survived by his mother Joyce; father Sandy; brother Benjamin; his loving aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces and nephew and his goddaughter Lauren; as well as a host of friends and co-workers; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Essex County Board of Chosen Freeholders hereby celebrates the life and mourns the passing of Scott Geiger and offers their heartfelt condolences to his family; and be it further

RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be presented to the family of Scott Geiger.
