IN MEMORIAM

CESAR AUGUSTO HUAMAN

WHEREAS, Cesar Augusto Huaman of Glen Ridge, New Jersey, is being remembered upon his passing from this life on Saturday, April 4, 2020, at the age of 65; and

WHEREAS, Cesar Augusto Huaman was born on October 7, 1954, in the city of Jauja (Junin, Peru), he was the first-born son of Vicente Huaman and Cecilia Quispilaya. He attended Jose Granda School and National University of Engineering (UNI) majoring in Electrical Engineering. He later achieved an M.S. in Electrical Engineering at the New Jersey Institute of Technology, followed by an MBA at the NYU Stern School of Business in 1996; and

WHEREAS, due to the loss of his father, Cesar Augusto Huaman was forced to work full-time and study part-time, however, he successfully completed his undergraduate degree in 1978. After a successful internship in the CentroMin mine, he was hired by the National Manufacturing Company of Iron (Hierro, Peru) followed by an opportunity with Indeco Peru, an electrical cable manufacturing company in Lima; and

WHEREAS, because of his outstanding work at Indeco, Cesar Augusto Huaman, was awarded a scholarship to study in London at Whip and Bourne, which also motivated him to learn English. On July 4, 1984, he arrived in New Jersey where he was eventually accepted in a program for new engineers at Westinghouse Engineering Services (WES) ultimately beginning his career there in Power Systems Maintenance; and

WHEREAS, on March 22, 1989, Cesar Augusto Huaman, married his college sweetheart from Amazonas, Peru, Lucy Lopez, a fellow civil engineer. Following their marriage, the couple settled in Passaic, New Jersey, where they purchased their first home and also welcomed their first and only son, Kenneth Huaman on August 12, 1997. He eventually moved his family to Glen Ridge, New Jersey, where his son completed high school before going to college to follow in his father's footsteps; and

WHEREAS, in 2006, Cesar Augusto Huaman founded HQ Power, an electrical engineering company dedicated to the maintenance of Power Stations, with Turtle & Hughes as his main client. From its inception, HQ Power was tasked with overseeing projects from beginning to end, including the new World Trade Center, NYU Langone Hospital, Lilly Pharmaceuticals, NY Port Authority Bus Terminal and Lately LaGuardia Airport, amongst many others; and

WHEREAS, Cesar Augusto Huaman had many interests, he loved to read and developed a passion for languages and learned Italian, Portuguese, German and French. He valued sports and was an avid volleyball and tennis player. He was also a music fanatic and enjoyed many genres and was known as the "life of the party"; and

WHEREAS, Cesar Augusto Huaman was an excellent husband, dedicated father, and committed family man. He helped many of his nieces and nephews to become accomplished professionals in their respective fields of work. He leaves to cherish endless memories, his wife Lucy; his son Kenneth; and countless extended family, colleagues and friends; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Essex County Board of Chosen Freeholders hereby celebrates the life and mourns the passing of Cesar Augusto Huaman, and offers their heartfelt condolences to his family; and be it further

RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be presented to the family of Cesar Augusto Huaman.
