WHEREAS, Carmine E. Capone of Fairfield, New Jersey, is being remembered upon his passing from this life on Sunday, June 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Carmine E. Capone was born and raised in Orange, New Jersey, to the late Carmine and Olympia (Mutascio) Capone; and

WHEREAS, in addition to owning a family business in Roseland, New Jersey, Carmine E. Capone put great importance on service to his community and the State of New Jersey, and held the following offices prior his retirement: Mayor of Orange, New Jersey, for 13 years, New Jersey Deputy Director of the Division of Local Government, Essex County Director of Parks and Public Works, Essex County Administrator and the Exalted Ruler of the Fraternal Order of Elks (Orange, New Jersey); and

WHEREAS, Carmine E. Capone served honorably in the U.S. Navy from 1945-1948 as a Radar man on three vessels (USS Albany, USS Providence and USS Portsmouth) and received a WWII Victory Medal and Navy Occupation Ribbon (Europe); and

WHEREAS, Carmine E. Capone was predeceased by his sister, Loretta (Capone) Piro, and his brother, Joe Capone. He is survived by his loving wife, Marie Capone (Perruso); his son, Mark Capone and his wife, Denise (Preziosi); his daughter, Pam Rafanello and her husband, Greg Campisi; his son, Gary Capone and his wife, Karen (Haimson), as well as his five grandchildren, Nicholas, Michael, Jamie, Lucas, and Tahlia. He is also survived by his brother, Anthony (Chuck) Capone and his wife, Betty; his sister, Anna Ippolito and her husband, Pat, and his sister-in-law, Mary Ann Capone; as well as many, other family, colleagues and friends; now, therefore, be it
