DIDIER (DANA) ADDISON WHITE

WHEREAS, Didier (Dana) Addison White of Middletown, Delaware, is being remembered upon his passing from this life on Tuesday, June 30, 2020, at the age of 69; and

WHEREAS, Didier Addison White lived in Montclair, New Jersey, prior to their moving to Middletown. He was born in Port of Spain, Trinidad to Rosanna Lynch (White) and Nellis Noel. He later lived in Boston and following his graduation from Danvers High School, he attended and graduated from Boston College receiving a Bachelor's degree in Political Science; and

WHEREAS, Didier Addison White worked as a Sales and Account Representative for several technology companies before leaving the private sector to pursue his interest in teaching in the Public Schools of Montclair, New Jersey. He served as a Mathematics and Science teacher in an Alternative High School Program. Later, he was a beloved technology teacher and guidance counselor at the Mount Hebron Middle School; and

WHEREAS, Didier Addison White was deeply committed to service and found many ways to contribute to the betterment of the Montclair community. He was a member of the Eureka Masonic Lodge in Montclair; served as a valued coach and coordinator for the Montclair Robotics competition; was a District Leader for the Montclair Democratic Committee; and served as Treasurer of the First Montclair House; and

WHEREAS, Didier Addison White was an avid sailor and enjoyed sailing the Long Island Sound with friends and colleagues. As a knowledgeable collector, he enjoyed visiting galleries, attending art shows, and became a patron of works of renown African and African American artists. He developed an impressive art collection; and

WHEREAS, over the years, Didier Addison White, accumulated a vast network of dear friends from Boston College while working in public education and through his involvement in community services; and

WHEREAS, Didier Addison White leaves behind the love of his life, Diane (Satterfield), his wife of 31 years; three sisters, Laurian (Bob) of St. Croix, Beverly of Denton, Texas, and Marcia of New York City; one brother, Euyen of New York City; and a host of nephews, nieces, and extended family and the friends from Boston College; now, therefore, be it
