The meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission was called to order by Vice Chairman Grant Wilinski. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the certification of compliance with the Open Public Meetings Law was read. The following members were in attendance: Cheryl Fetty, James Kerrigan, John Kurtz, William Sacchinelli and Sam Wells (arrived late). Ronald McArthur was absent.

Minutes

On the motion of John Kurtz, second of James Kerrigan and carried by unanimous voice vote the minutes of April 12, 2012 were approved as presented.

Applications

#17-2012 Angela Garland-6068 Main St.-Bl. 742 Lot 4

Application to replace fence. It was noted that a stockade fence has already been placed on the property. The applicant was asked to cut off the top of the fence in order to “dog ear” the points of the fence at approximately two inches from the top. The applicant agreed to do this. On the motion of William Sacchinelli, second of James Kerrigan the amended application was approved with the following roll call vote. (Fetty, abstain; Kerrigan, aye; Kurtz, aye; Sacchinelli, aye; Wells, abstain; Wilinski, aye).

Announcements

Cheryl Fetty announced that there will be a tree lighting ceremony this year as money was placed in the budget for decorating the park.

Correspondence

A letter was received from the Township Administrator requesting a letter of support for the Transportation Enhancement Grant. On the motion of John Kurtz, second of Sam Wells the secretary was instructed to prepare a letter to the Township Administrator stating that the HPC supports the efforts to obtain funding for this project subject to a presentation being made before the HPC concerning the project details including color, materials and type of paving. Motion carried with 5 yes votes and one abstention. Mr. Sacchinelli abstained.

A letter was received from Leslie A. MacDonnell (Atlantic County Div. of Facilities & Property Management & Capital Projects) asking to schedule a tour of the renovated 1800's Jail located in the back of the Mays Landing Historic Complex. The secretary was asked to arrange a tour before the August 9, 2012 meeting with alternate dates of August 8 or 7.

Memorializations

On the motion of William Sacchinelli, second of Sam Wells and carried by unanimous voice vote memorialization #3-2012, #7-2012, #10-2012, #12-2012, #13-2012, #15-2012, #16-2012 were approved as presented.

On the motion of William Sachinelli, second of John Kurtz and carried with a vote of 5 in favor and 1 abstention memorialization #8-2012, 9-2012 and 14-2012 were approved as presented. William Sachinelli abstained.
