Applications

Application #26-2012 Millennium Mechanical- 115 Route 50 Bl 757 Lot 10-11

Application to replace two air condition units on roof and to add a third air condition unit either on the ground or on the roof. The applicant stated that he preferred to have the unit on the ground but was awaiting word from the Pinelands before making the final decision on that. Mr. Kurtz stated that none of the units will be visible from the street. On the motion of John Kurtz, second of James Kerrigan and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the application was approved as presented.

Application #27-2012 Presbyterian Church of Mays Landing-6001 Main St Bl 757 Lot 14

Application to replace existing wood fence. The application was presented by Rev. Ash and Scott Ehrlich, Chairman of the Building and Grounds Committee. On the motion of John Kurtz, second of Cheryl Fetty and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the application was approved as presented.
