This meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission was called to order by Chairman Grant Wilinski. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the certification of compliance with the Open Public Meetings Law was read. In addition to the Chairman the following members were in attendance: Carl Farrell, Cheryl Fetty, James Kerrigan and John Kurtz. Ronald McArthur, William Sacchinelli and Sam Wells were absent.

Minutes

On the motion of Cheryl Fetty, second of James Kerrigan and carried by a unanimous voice vote, the minutes of June 12, 2014 were approved as presented.

Applications

Application #12- 2014- Nella House – Bl 732 Lot 68 – 61 Mill St.
Application to add fire escape. The applicant was not present. The secretary stated that she had personally called the applicant to go over the application and told the applicant the meeting date as well as following up with a reminder letter that was sent to the address provided on the application.

Application #15-2014- Presbyterian Church- Bl 757 Lot 14- 6001 Main St.
Application for signage. On the motion of John Kurtz, second of Cheryl Fetty and carried by unanimous roll call vote the application was approved as presented.

Subcommittee Reports – Application for Solar Panels-Bl 757 Lot 19- 6015 Main St.

Cheryl Fetty reported that it was the recommendation of the sub-committee to deny the application because the panels would be visible from the street. Mrs. Fetty stated that she had contacted the State Historic Preservation Office and that was the recommendation. John Kurtz described a new type of solar roof that will be available in the future that replaces the shingle and is only available in black. Mr. Kurtz said that he had spoken to the applicant about using the new product as a possible alternative.

On the motion of Carl Farrell, second of James Kerrigan and carried by a unanimous roll call vote the application was denied.

Memorializations

On the motion of John Kurtz, second of Cheryl Fetty and carried by unanimous voice, the following Memorializations were approved: #7-2014, #8-2014, #10-2014, #11-2014, #13-2014. On the motion of James Kerrigan, second of Carl Farrell and carried by a vote of four in favor and one abstention, Memorialization # 14-2014 was approved as presented. Cheryl Fetty abstained.
