

**TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON
ORDINANCE NO. 1822-2016**

**CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF VARIOUS
EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT BY THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, IN THE
COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING \$450,000
THEREFOR**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
HAMILTON, IN THE COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1.

The purposes and improvements described in Section 2 of this ordinance are hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Township of Hamilton, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, as general improvements. For the improvements or purposes described in Section 2, there is hereby appropriated the sum of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000) as required by the Local Bond Law. The total sum is now available by virtue of the existing Capital Improvement Fund Balance.

SECTION 2.

The Township hereby authorizes the appropriation of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000) from the Township Capital Improvement Fund for the purpose of purchasing various emergency equipment for the Township, such equipment having a reasonably estimated useful life of at least five (5) years.

SECTION 3.

The purposes and improvements described in Section 2 of this ordinance are not current expenses. They are all improvements or purposes that the Township may lawfully undertake as general improvements, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefited thereby.

SECTION 4.

Any grant moneys received for the purposes described in Section 2 hereof shall be applied to the direct payment of the cost of the improvements.

SECTION 5.

The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget. The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital budget, a revised capital budget will be filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

SECTION 6.

This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after the first publication thereof after final adoption by the law.
